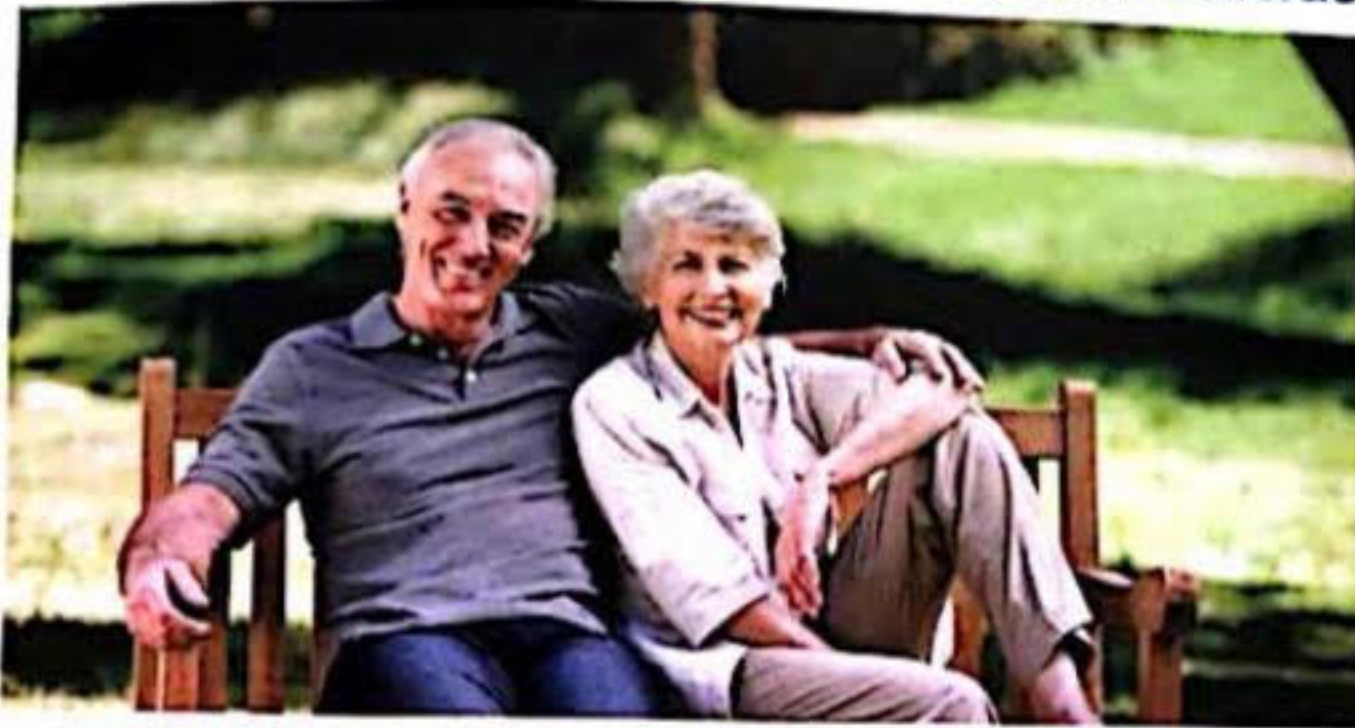


FREE Assistance for Family Caregivers of Someone with Alzheimer's Disease and Other Dementias
